

Warning against Plagiarism

Plagiarism is a serious offence and students who are found guilty of plagiarism will be liable to disciplinary actions including a published reprimand, suspension of study, and even expulsion from the University.

The school follows the BA guidelines and, in particular, that if a student committed the offence, s/he will be given a chance to be heard at a meeting or in writing and is liable to disciplinary actions for established cases. Any plagiarized work will receive a fail grade and the case will be reported via the Chief Examiner to the BoE and kept in the student's file.
